Minutes of the Certification Meeting of the Board of Education of the Elmont Union Free School District, Town of Hempstead, Nassau County, New York, held remotely on Wednesday, June 17, 2020.

The purpose of the meeting was to certify the vote on the Elmont Union Free School District Budget, the Sewanhaka Central High School District Budget and the Elmont Public Library Budget. The Board also certified the vote on the School Board Candidates and Library Board Candidates. Voting was held by absentee ballot only, (accepting all ballots through Tuesday, June 16, 2020 @ 5:00 PM).

Mr. Jaime welcomed everyone to the meeting and led the pledge of allegiance.

Mr. Jaime turned the meeting over to Mr. Nugent for the results of the election.

RESULTS OF THE ELECTION

We started receiving ballots over the last few weeks. We conducted the election in accordance with the executive order issued by the governor late in the day on May 1, 2020. The regular meeting was postposed because of the Coronavirus pandemic. His executive order 202.26 directed that the meeting be held in accordance with essentially the absentee voter law but with certain changes. We conducted the meeting in accordance with the executive order as it modified the standing law. Where it didn't address applicable statues in the election law, we used the standing statutes where we could. The executive order directives were that we send a ballot to every registered voter in our District. That was done (35,359 ballots were sent out). With each ballot we were required to send out 3 envelopes. The time in which to complete the election was extended by the governor. He originally set June 9th as the date the ballots could be counted and then extended it to June 16th at 5:00 PM. We accepted ballots until 5:00 PM on June 16th. The counting took place starting Tuesday, June 16th after 5:00 PM and continued today. It was a remarkable job. The work performed by Diana Delahanty, Anna Barbagallo and Celestine Lloyd was spectacular in what they did to get the ballots out and then the painstaking task of counting all the ballots. There were many other people involved in the process of sending them out and counting the ballots. They did excellent work.

The District Clerk and I can attest to the fact that the election was conducted in accordance with the applicable statutes of the State of New York and the governor's executive order as we understand it to be and as we know it. We offer the following results without reservation.
