On a motion by Ms. Taylor-Bass, seconded by Mr. Meikle, the Board denied the application for an exemption as follows:

IT IS RESOLVED, that the Board of Education herewith addresses the application of a designated student for exemption from vaccinations required by Public Health Law §2164 and the regulations of the Commissioner of Health, 10 NYCCRR §66-1, on the grounds set forth in PHL §2164(9) granting an exemption based upon religious beliefs. The Board has reviewed Petitioner's application together with letters submitted by her. The Board has further reviewed the decision rendered by the school principal, has reviewed the recommendation for denial of the application by the Director of Pupil Personnel Services, and the Superintendent of Schools. The Board has further reviewed the Answer to the Petition to the Commissioner submitted on the District's behalf.

After due and careful consideration of the facts and circumstances in this matter, the Board finds that the application is motivated by the Petitioner's fear of an adverse medical consequence to the subject child from the immunizations. The Board therefore denies the application for an exemption. (See backup pages for further information)
