AUDIOLOGICAL SERVICES FOR DEAF/IIEARING IMPAIRED

- 1. Otological Examination annual
- 2. Audiological Assessment (aided and unaided) semi-annual
- Hearing Aid evaluation (fitting for a new aid) every 2 or 3 years. (This does not include the purchase of the hearing aid, batteries, or repairs to hearing aid.)
- 4. Hearing Aid Analysis (recheck of aid) as needed.
